Nurse Aide Training Requirement
State Tested Nurse Aide (STNA)**

Pre-Licensure Students ONLY

As part of the requirements for starting the nursing program, you will need to successfully complete an Ohio Department of Health Nurse Aide Training course (minimum 75 hours).

You can locate an approved program according to county at:

It is highly encouraged that you take the State Nurse Aide State Registry examination upon completion of the program, which will place your name on the Ohio Nurse Aide Registry (information on state testing can be found at

http://hdmaster.com/testing/cnatesting/ohio/OH_STNA_Home.htm.

This would permit you to work as a Nurse Aide in a health care facility.

It is not required that you take the state test for entrance to the WSU nursing program. The Ohio Department of Health certificate of successful course completion is what you load into your CastleBranch account for compliance.

If you have been advised that the nurse aide course requirement has been waived for you, do not load anything into CastleBranch. The WSU Castle Branch administrator will override that area of your account.
